## **Scripture**

**John 1:35–41 (ESV):** <sup>35</sup>The next day again John was standing with two of his disciples, <sup>36</sup>and he looked at Jesus as He walked by and said, “Behold, the Lamb of God!”

<sup>37</sup>The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. <sup>38</sup>Jesus turned and saw them following and said to them, “What are you seeking?” And they said to Him, “Rabbi”, “where are you staying?” <sup>39</sup>He said to them, “Come and you will see.” So they came and saw where He was staying, and they stayed with Him that day, for it was about the tenth hour. <sup>40</sup>One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother. <sup>41</sup>He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, “We have found the Messiah”.

**John 6:8–9 (ESV):** <sup>8</sup>One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, said to Him, <sup>9</sup>“There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish, but what are they for so many?”

**John 12:20–22 (ESV):** <sup>20</sup>Now among those who went up to worship at the feast were some Greeks. <sup>21</sup>So these came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and asked him, “Sir, we wish to see Jesus.” <sup>22</sup>Philip went and told Andrew; Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus.
